Acceptance Procedures:

- A prospective Contemporary Dance Minor student must complete the following minor approval process before being accepted as a Contemporary Dance Minor.

Complete:

- Dance 241R with a grade of B- or better*
- or**
- Audition and acceptance into one of the three contemporary dance companies. (Contemporary Dance Theatre, Kinnect, or dancEnsemble)

*In the Dance Department, a grade of B- must be attained in a course designated as a *technique* course before a student can advance to the technique course of the next level. The *passing* grade for the course if the student does not wish to advance to the next technique level is the same for any dance major or minor course i.e. C-.

- Fill out this form and submit it into Kate Monson, Assistant Professor of Dance (office 291 RB), and submit a copy to the Fine Arts and Communications College Advisement Center, D444 HFAC (which in turn, will forward it to the College Advisement Center responsible for the student's major.)
- Provide a Full Progress (ABC) Report, which can be found online at byu.edu, with courses that will be applied to the minor highlighted.

Please Note:

- This dance minor does not provide public school certification.
- A class used in a student's primary major cannot be used in a minor or second major without prior approval. Please see your advisor for details.
- Any upper level technique class can be substituted for a lower level technique class with Dance Department approval.
- Should minor course substitutions/transfers result in credit hour deficiencies; these deficiencies must be met. In other words, this minor cannot be completed with less than 18.5 credit hours. Please see your advisor for details.
